
Once again we find ourselves completely satisfied with the performance of our Weir-Wolf Systems. The new units your staff installed about eight months ago are performing just perfectly. As you will recall we had you install the system on our final clarifiers back in 1999, and had been trying to get the funds into our budget to place the system on our primary clarifiers since that time.

Thus far we've found that the Weir Wolf System has saved us potable water that we once used to manually wash the weirs and launders with and a great deal of labor and time. We are a small staff and any time I can use the personnel to perform tasks other than standing with a hose washing down units is a true asset. Certainly everyone wants to conserve potable water when ever possible. That's a waste and an expense we truly didn't need. As you know, some modifications had to be made on the primary units to allow smooth operation of the system, but your staff made those changes without any problems.

In the approximately seven year span since we first got the Weir-Wolf System installed on the final clarifiers, we've noticed that the suspended solids we measure in our effluent has remained pretty constant and we no longer have spikes as we did when we manually cleaned the weirs and launders. The safety factor and time savings alone have merited the small amount we spent to have them installed.

Please convey my appreciation to the field staff for their professional performance here at our facility. It's always a joy to work with your staff.


